Dear Mr White

We, the undersigned, are writing to you to complain about Bridgnorth District Council. A number of residents are currently in dispute with them regarding the repair or replacement of various treatment plants throughout the Bridgnorth area.

While we understand that you will not involve yourselves in legal matters as to the rights or wrongs of specific contracts we would like you to investigate the way in which we are being treated by Bridgnorth District Council.

While many of us have specific concerns which need to be investigated the following are some of the general concerns which we feel you could help us with.

1. There has been a consistent and continual refusal by the council to answer questions which we feel that they, as a public body, should answer.
2. Requests for copies of documents which should be a matter of public record have been either refused or ignored entirely.
3. We have been given an ultimatum that we must pay what is potentially an unlimited future amount.
4. They are ignoring the fact that they must also abide by legal agreements in current deeds.

This behaviour has left us feeling that we are being bullied and our rights trampled upon.

Given this we believe your involvement in this dispute is warranted.
